One day there was a little girl. Her name was Daisy.



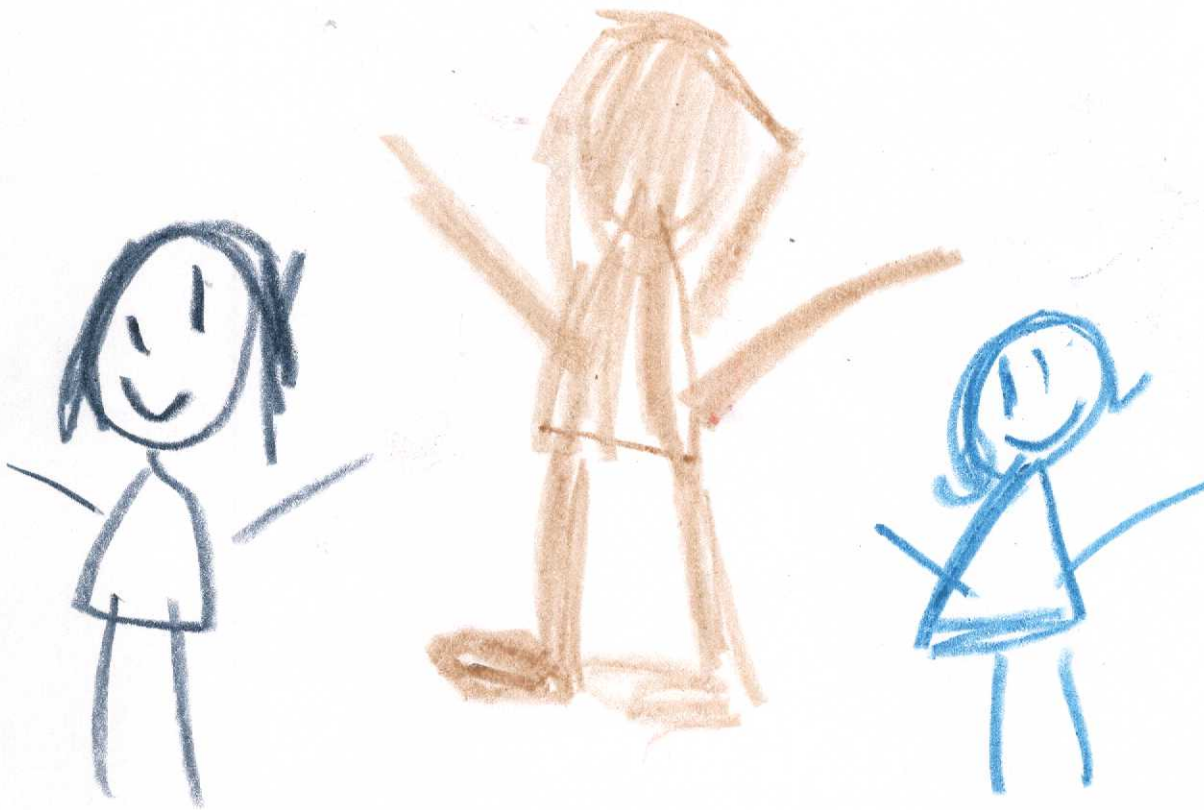
One lovely morning, she decided to take a walk. She grabbed her hat, and went out the door...

Then Daisy went back outside to play, but she couldn't go anywhere but the house. She practiced jump rope and then she played on her skates.



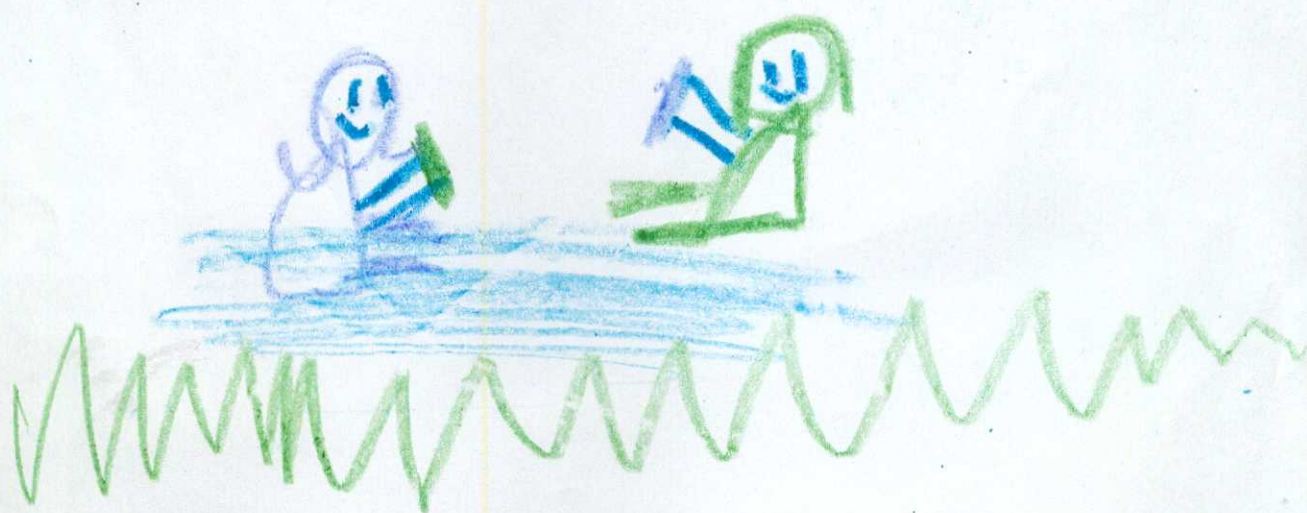
Later her friend, Lily, came over to play. When Lily came over they built figures out of sticks.

So, then Daisy and Lily went on her trampoline.



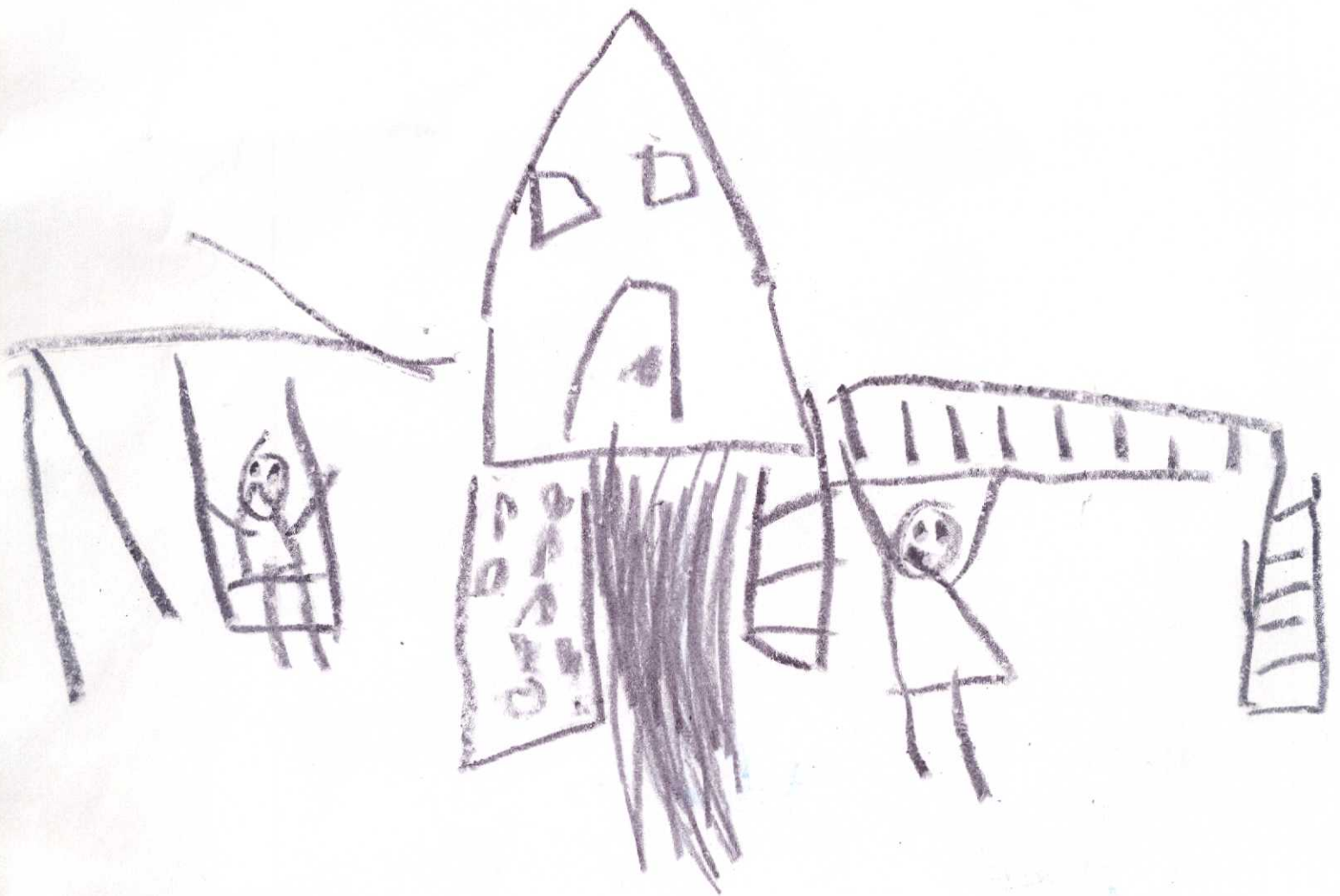
Daisy's mom came out to see what she was up to and asked if Daisy and Lily wanted popsicles. So, then they took a break to enjoy their popsicles.
